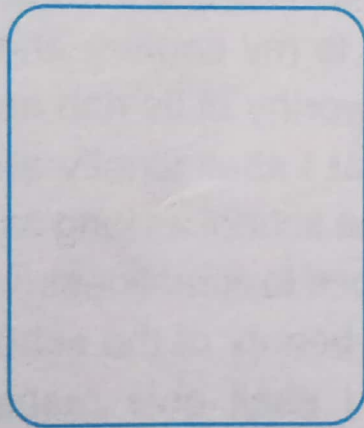

RULES OF CONDUCT

1. All pupils should come to be the school in proper uniform. Non without proper uniform shall be admitted to the class.
2. The School uniform should be clean, complete and well pressed.
3. Pupils should have text books and note books as prescribed by the school. They should bring to class the books as per the daily routine.
4. all the students are supposed to be present in the morning prayer and assembly for attendance.
5. Pupils shall keep their classes and the school premises clean and tidy. They shall contribute to the maintenance of the prestige and fair name of the institution. They shall not disfigure the wall scatter bites of paper on the flow, dirty the walls and floors of the school, damage the school furniture, and commit any unhygienic and objectionable act. The pupil found violating this rule shall be punished. The punishment may be heavy fine, suspension or even expulsion.
6. No pupil will ordinarily be allowed to leave the class during the teaching periods.
7. As per regards action taken for violation of these rules Principal's decision will final and binding.

RULES OF ATTENDANCE

1. No pupils shall absents himself/herself form the class without obtaining prior permission of the class teacher, if prior permission cannot be had on grounds of health or unforeseen circumstances, and application for leave shall be sent to the class teacher, not leater than the following day.
2. All applications of leave shall be attested by the parents. Application for leave for a period not

exceeding five days shall be sent to the class teacher and for a longer period to the principal.

3. Late - comers will be suitably punished.
4. Irregularity in attendance, unpunctuality on the part of pupils will be specially dealt with by the principal on reports from the class teachers.
5. No pupils shall be eligible for promotion unless he or she puts in an attendance of 75% of the total number of working days in the whole year.

TRANSFER

1. Fees will be charged for transfer certificate
2. School fees and other dues are charged up to the Month of issue of T.c.
3. The transfer certificate is issued only after an application submitted by the guardians or parents before three working days.

NOTES TO PARENTS

1. Parents are requested to contact only the principal and not to go directly to the classes for any reason whatsoever. The procedure, it is hoped, will assist the school authorities in assuring the least disturbances to the efficient working of the classes.
2. The parents and guardians are further requested
 - (a) To go through the Progress Reports issued to their children and co-operate us in remedying the defects observed.
 - (b) To ensure that fees are paid in time.
 - (c) And to use this diary as a means of communication
